Join Brian Jorg Saturday March 27th, on a guided wildflower hike at beautiful John Bryan State Park and adjacent Clifton Gorge State Nature Preserve in Yellow Springs, Ohio. Hikers will meet at the **Orton Picnic Area parking lot** at 9:30 am, and will hike the gorge till early afternoon.

On this early spring walk, we should see the previously state endangered Snow Trillium, colorful hepatica, as well as other harbingers of spring. You can pack a lunch, or join the rest of us at the Clifton Mill for a sit down lunch.

Feel free to bring field guides and binoculars if you have them.

Transportation and lunch will be on your own.

- It may sprinkle at some point. Please bring raingear for the light stuff. We will get out of the weather in the heavier rain.

- If you have a nametag please bring it along.
- The trails we have chosen are moderate and the pace will be accommodating for the group. Please wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the hikes. Attendees should be able to walk over uneven ground, and be able to walk moderate distances
