

# Smoky Mountain Wildflower Photography Class

*Focus on Flowers*  
**April 19<sup>th</sup>-21st, 2013**

We will meet in Gatlinburg TN on Friday, April 19th, at 6 o'clock at the Brookside Resort. We will then leave for an evening hike. Saturday will involve hikes in the morning and afternoon, with a break in town for lunch. Sunday, we will have a morning hike that will last till approximately noon.

**Class fee per Participant: \$125**

*Transportation, lodging and meals will be on your own.*

- This class is geared towards beginners. Participants should have a good general knowledge of their camera (How to change aperture, shutter speed, etc.). Attending the *Fundamentals of Digital Photography* is a good class to attend before this field shoot.
- Please bring your typical landscape and flower set up. I will be using my 28-80mm, 70-200mm with extension tubes, and an external flash unit for most of my images.  
*A solid tripod is a must!*
- We will meet at Brookside at 6:00PM Friday evening in the lobby. Brookside Resort's phone number is 1-800-251-9597
- It will sprinkle at some point. Please bring raingear for the light stuff. We will get out of the weather in the heavier rain.
- We will have an itinerary, but will remain flexible to make changes that will enhance the trip.
- We will have breakfast before we leave in the morning (we will leave for the trailhead around 8:00 am), and have lunch around midday. Please feel free to bring snacks during the duration of the day.
- The trails we have chosen are moderate and the pace will be accommodating for the group. Please wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the hikes. Attendees should be able to walk over uneven ground, and be able to walk moderate distances
